

## Care & Maintenance ■

### Promenade® Seating

KI Promenade Seating requires minimal maintenance. Periodic inspection of attaching hardware and floor mounting bolts, if applicable, is recommended (every six to eight months).

Plastic components and powdercoated surfaces can be kept clean with a soap and water solution.

High-pressure laminates are used on in-line and end table units. To clean these laminate surfaces, use a mild solution of water and detergent. (Pine-Sol and warm water works very well.) Wipe clean with a dry cloth. As a last resort, stubborn dirt or grease may be removed with lacquer thinner or other solvents. Some stains such as grape juice may be removed by wetting the table surface and sprinkling lightly with baking soda, then wipe clean with a damp cloth. (Do not allow the baking soda to remain more than two minutes.) Always thoroughly dry the surface with a dry cloth. Never use a harsh abrasive such as Comet cleanser, scrub pads, etc., to clean the surface. To maintain a bright attractive surface, occasionally apply a coating of wax (the same that is used on home furniture) to the laminate surface.

Never use excessive water to clean any of the table units. In the event a table becomes wet, thoroughly dry both sides of the table with a dry cloth as soon as possible. Wetness or excessive moisture can cause a table to swell and it may warp or appear to grow in thickness.

Do not use these cleaning products:

- Solvent based cleaners such as mineral oil, mineral spirits or turpentine.
- Citrus cleaners (all contain high levels of citric acids that penetrate plastic).
- Orange oil based cleaners (all contain citric acid).
- Heavy-duty cleaners such as Fantastic, 409 and other aggressive industrial cleaners that are designed for bathrooms and kitchens.
- Powered cleaners such as Ajax or Bon Ami.

Fabric Upholstery – Use a foam-type cleaner such as Johnson Wax “Glory” or Earl Grissmer Co. “Blue Lustre” for general cleaning. For more stubborn spots and stains, use Texie Chemical Co. “K2r”. Always follow the manufacturer’s directions.
